<p>Requirements for <u>initial</u> Three -Year Alternate Route License</p> <p>(non-renewable)</p>	<p>Eight Week Training Session - 9 semester hours at the graduate level; on-campus <i>(Times and dates determined by offering colleges/universities)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program includes teaching strategies, classroom management, state curriculum requirements, instructional methods and tests and measurements. <p>Eight Week Training Session – Not for credit certificate program; online</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program includes teaching strategies, classroom management, state curriculum requirements, instructional methods and tests and measurements. <p>Upon completion of TMI program Part I (either summer coursework or online):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The applicant must contact TMI and request an online recommendation, after the training program is completed. The applicant must then apply to the online recommendation in the Educator Licensure Management System (ELMS) https://sso.mde.ms.gov/Login/Login.aspx . 2. Sealed transcripts from all college coursework, including bachelor’s degree, must be sent to the Office of Educator Licensure. The transcript(s) must be submitted in a sealed envelope(s) bearing the seal or signature of the registrar. The Office of Educator Licensure is also now accepting electronic transcripts through eScrip-Safe from those institutions that are members of eScrip and can send electronic transcripts. <i>The electronic transcript must be sent directly from the institution to the Mississippi Department of Education.</i> 3. Praxis CORE and subject area scores must be on file in the ELMS account. To verify that scores were sent from ETS, the applicant can click on “Tests” in ELMS. <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The initial TMI license is a three-year license issued only at the bachelor’s level</i></p> <p>Supplemental endorsements may be added to a three-year TMI license. <p>Requirements for Five Year Renewable Alternate Route License</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicant must contact the TMI college/university attended and request an online recommendation, after the program is completed. The applicant must then apply to the online recommendation in ELMS: https://sso.mde.ms.gov/Login/Login.aspx . 2. The applicant must have completed one year of internship with mentoring and induction in a local school district. 3. The applicant must submit a letter from that district recommending issuance of a five year license. <p>After obtaining the five-year license, salary for teachers in this program will be based on the 3rd year salary schedule.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Supplemental endorsements can be added to a five year license.</i></p>
